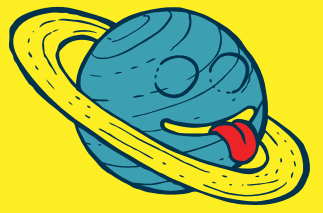


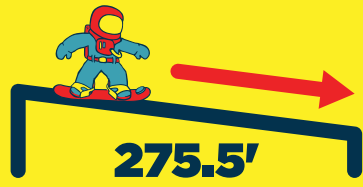
FUN SNOWBOARD FACTS!

The largest snowflake ever seen was 15 inches wide.



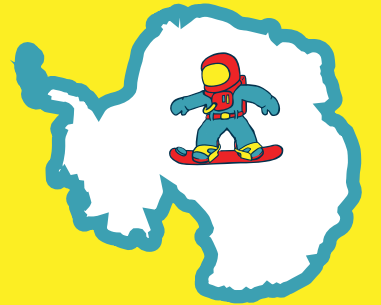
The largest snowman ever built was 113 feet high.



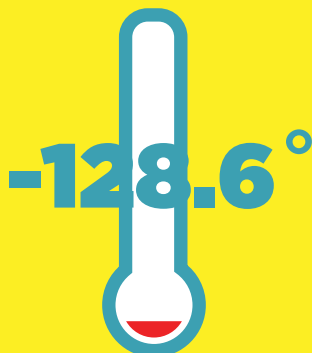
Shaun White has won the more X-Games medals than any other snowboarder - 16.
